Section 5 - Ladies Championship – Revised 2024 (following agreement at the Ladies' AGM 2023)

The Ladies Championship will be played over 36 holes in conjunction with the Men's Championship over 2 days with 18 holes to be played on each day. Ladies will play together in groups which will be played in blocks within the whole competition.

On the first day (Saturday) players can elect to play either in the early or later slots on the first day. Ladies will be allocated tee times by the Pro Shop in handicap order during both early and late times.

On the second day (Sunday), Ladies will again play together, in best score order, towards the end of the field but ahead of the last few groups of men.

Detail of the procedure for the day can be found in:

Club Procedure Document No 5 – Club Championships.

Trophies:

The Lady with the lowest gross score over 36 holes will be the Lady Club Champion and will be awarded the **Champion's Trophy**.

Note: In the event of a tie for best gross score there will be a playoff using the 1st, 4th and 18th holes.

The Lady with the best nett score over 36 holes will be awarded the **Handicap Salver**.

It has subsequently been agreed that the Lady who returns the best nett score over 18 holes on the Sunday will be awarded the **Tarrant Trophy.** Only those Ladies who have entered the 36 hole championship are eligible to win this trophy.

Note: In the event of a tie in the Handicap competitions then there will be a countback of the last 9, 6, 3 holes.

Trophies will be presented on completion of the competition on the Sunday evening.

Prizes:

In addition to the trophies the following prizes will be awarded and presented at the Ladies presentation event(s):

- Best Gross 36 holes
- Best Nett 36 holes (Note 1)
- Best Nett (Day 2) 18 holes
- Runner-up Gross 36 Holes
- Runner-up Nett 36 Holes
- Runner-up Nett (Day 2) 18 Holes

Notes:

It was agreed at the AGM 2023 that in the event the same player recorded both the Best Gross and Best Nett scores over 36 holes then the player with the 2nd best overall Nett score would receive that prize.

This does not apply to the Best Nett 18 holes on the Sunday which is deemed to be a separate competition.

Other Competitions:

The following competitions previously played on Club Championship day will be played as usual on the following Tuesday:

- 1. Veterans Cup: 18 Hole Competition for Ladies aged 70 and over
- 2. Elderberry Cup: 9 Hole Competition for Ladies aged 80 or over
- 3. 18 Hole Competition for those Ladies not eligible to play in the above 2 competitions

These competitions will be available to book on BRS 2 weeks ahead as usual, with sign in to the chosen competition in the Pro Shop on the day.

These competitions are separate from the Club Championship so Ladies are free to play both at the weekend and on the Tuesday should they so wish.

The trophies will be presented at the Ladies presentation evening
